Our Vision

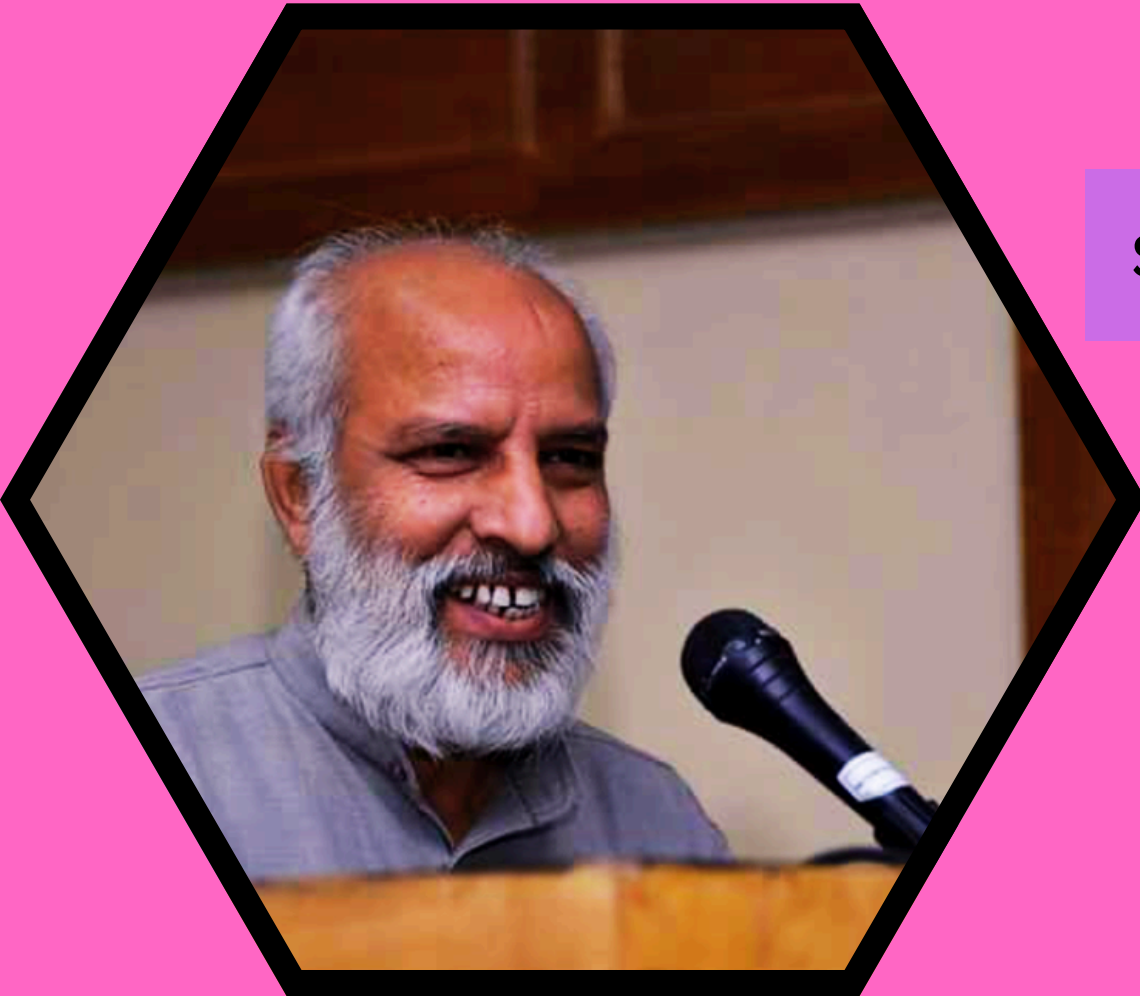
This Organization strives to achieve its target through a three pronged strategy:-

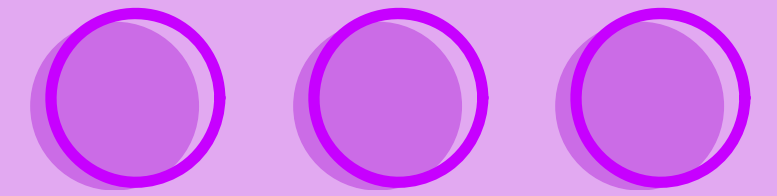

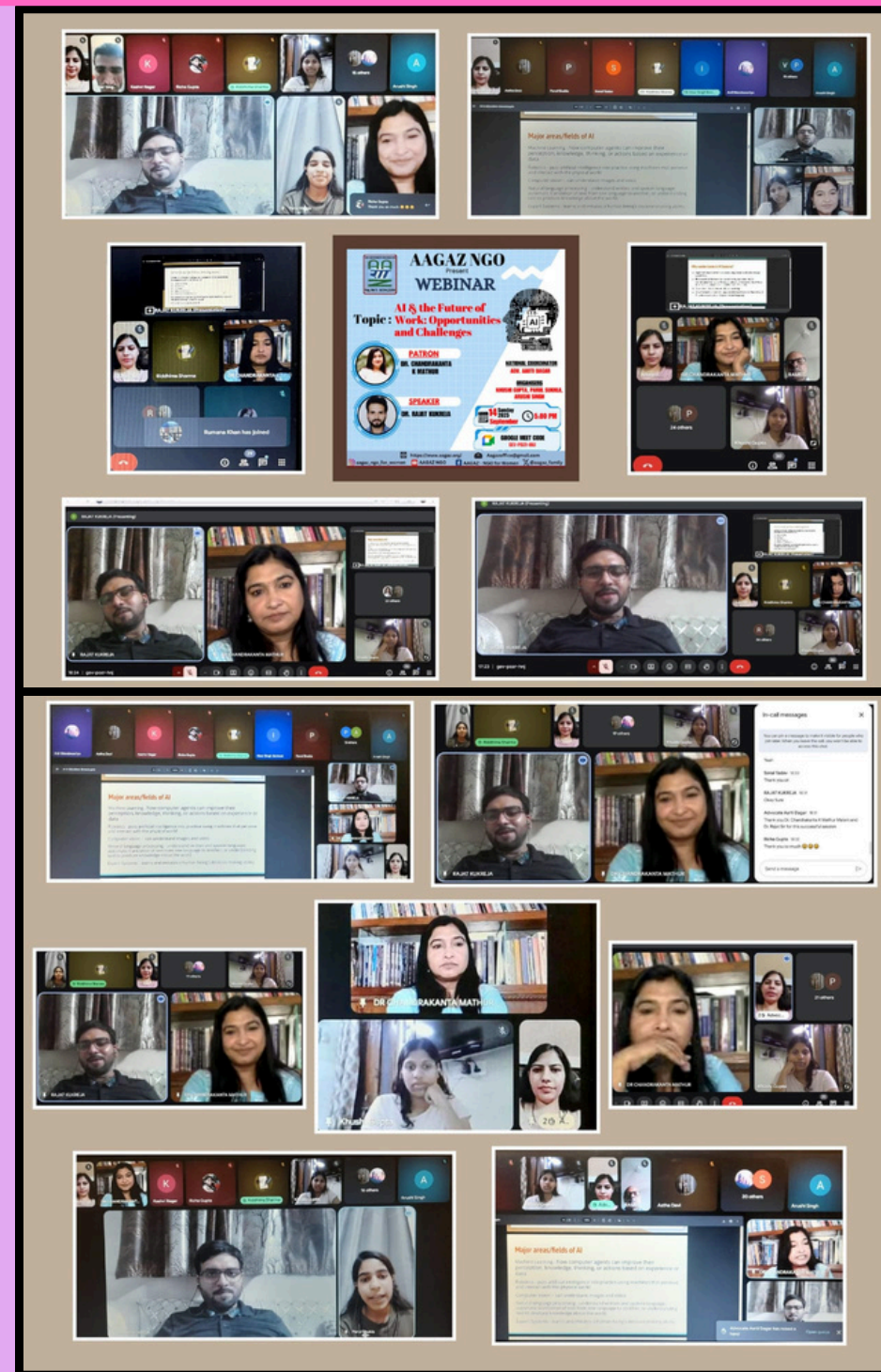

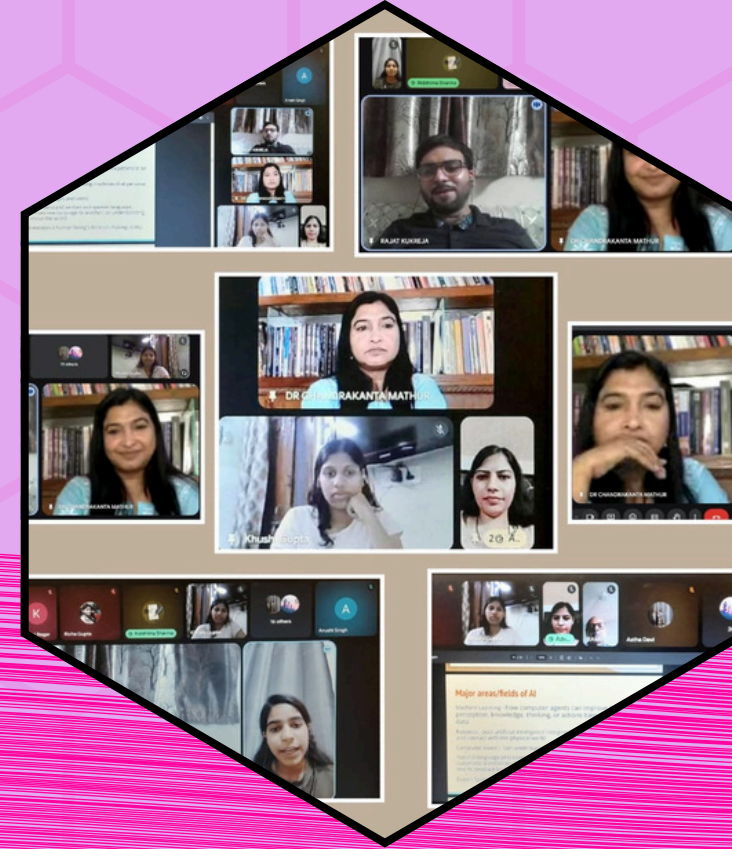
